JOB 38:1-7 NIV

1 Then the Lord spoke to Job out of the storm. He said: 2 "Who is this that obscures my plans with words without knowledge? 3 Brace yourself like a man; I will question you, and you shall answer me. 4 Where were you when I laid the earth's foundation? Tell me, if you understand. 5 Who marked of its dimensions? Surely you know! Who stretched a measuring line across it? 6 On what were its footings set or who laid its cornerstone - 7 while the morning stars sang together and all the angels shouted for joy?"

JOB 42:1-6, 12-13, 16-17 NIV

1 Then Job replied to the Lord: "I know that you can do all things; no purpose of yours can be thwarted. 2 You asked, 'Who is this that obscures my plans without knowledge?' Surely I spoke of things I did not understand, things too wonderful for me to know. 4 You said, 'Listen now, and I will speak; I will question you, and you shall answer me.' 5 My ears had heard of you but now my eyes have seen you. 6 Therefore I despise myself and repent in dust and ashes."

12 The Lord blessed the latter part of Job's life more than the former part. He had fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels, a thousand yoke of oxen and a thousand donkeys. 13 And he also had seven sons and three daughters.
