MATTHEW 28:16-20 (NIV)

Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. 17 When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. 18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

MATTHEW 4:18-20 (NIV)

As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. 19 "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people." 20 At once they left their nets and followed him.

ACTS 1:8-11 (NIV)

(Jesus said) "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." 9 After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight. 10 They were looking intently up into the sky as he was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. 11 "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven."

QUESTIONS TO PONDER:

Read Matthew 28:16-20. What instruction does Jesus give the disciples? Why do you think verse 18 is included? Jesus' new commandment was to "love like I do." (John 13:34) How does this change the way you see these verses? What comfort does Jesus give in verse 20?

Read Matthew 4:18-20. Peter and Andrew dropped their nets, but Jesus also "redefined" them. How does the way you approach your job / vocation look differently because of your faith in Jesus?

Read Acts 1:8-11. What sticks out to you? What's strange or surprising? What do you think God might be speaking to you through these verses?

A VERSE TO MEMORIZE:

Acts 1:8 (NIV) - "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."
