

WEEK 2: WHAT HAPPENED TO ME

PHILIPPIANS 1:12-21, 25-26 (NIV)

Now I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that what has happened to me has actually served to advance the gospel. 13 As a result, it has become clear throughout the whole palace guard and to everyone else that I am in chains for Christ. 14 And because of my chains, most of the brothers and sisters have become confident in the Lord and dare all the more to proclaim the gospel without fear.

15 It is true that some preach Christ out of envy and rivalry, but others out of goodwill. 16 The latter do so out of love, knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel. 17 The former preach Christ out of selfish ambition, not sincerely, supposing that they can stir up trouble for me while I am in chains. 18 But what does it matter? The important thing is that in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is preached. And because of this I rejoice. Yes, and I will continue to rejoice, 19 for I know that through your prayers and God's provision of the Spirit of Jesus Christ what has happened to me will turn out for my deliverance. 20 I eagerly expect and hope that I will in no way be ashamed, but will have sufficient courage so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death. 21 For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.

25 Convinced of this, I know that I will remain, and I will continue with all of you for your progress and joy in the faith, 26 so that through my being with you again your boasting in Christ Jesus will abound on account of me.

Read Philippians 1:12-30. What has happened to Paul in verse 12, and how has it "served to advance the gospel"? What hard things in your story can God use to point others to your hope in Jesus?

What does Paul mean, "To live is Christ?" What does "to die is gain" mean? In what way is Paul's situation a win/win situation? How can you "live Jesus" this week?

A VERSE TO MEMORIZE:

Philippians 1:21 (NLT) - For to me, living means living for Christ, and dying is even better.

TAKE A STEP:

Paul is convinced that he is still alive to tell people about Jesus. Who in your life needs to know that Jesus loves them? What's one step you can take to show / tell them that?
